Use these facts to promote discussion and reminiscing.

- 1. Elvis Aaron Presley was an identical twin. His brother (Jesse Garon) was born stillborn ½ hr before Elvis.
- 2. Elvis was born on 8th January 1934 in Tupelo, Mississippi.
- 3. Elvis Presley's parents were Vernon and Gladys Presley.
- 4. Elvis' favourite sandwich was peanut butter and banana.
- 5. Elvis died from a heart attack at the age of 42 on 16^{th} August 1977.
- 6. Elvis served time in the US Army 1957 1960. He was stationed in Germany during that time.
- 7. Elvis met Pricilla while serving in the US army in Germany. He was 24 and she was 14. They married 8 years later (1967-1973).
- 8. Elvis and Priscilla had one child called Lisa Marie born 1st Feb 1968.
- 9. Elvis recorded "Always On My Mind" for Priscilla.
- 10. Elvis' hair was dyed black as his natural colour was brown.
- 11. Elvis was 6' tall and wore size 11 shoes.
- 12. Besides the "King of Rock" he was also known as "Elvis the Pelvis".
- 13. Elvis starred in 31 movies and 2 concert documentaries.
- 14. Elvis recorded more than 600 songs in his music career but did not write a single song (impossible to confirm, but he was given co-writing credit on many songs because his label demanded songwriters give up 50% of the credit before Presley would record it).
- 15. Elvis was a Karate fan and earned a black belt in Karate in 1960.
- 16. Elvis bought "Graceland' (Memphis Tennessee) when he was 22
- 17. When Elvis was first played on the radio the DJ's had trouble convincing the public he was a white man.
- 18. Elvis' first No 1 hit was Heartbreak Hotel. Elvis' first movie was "Love Me Tender" in 1956. It is also the only film in which Elvis' character dies.
- 19. Elvis was a self-taught musician who played "by ear". He could play guitar, piano and the bass.
- 20. Elvis bought his first guitar when he was 11 and made his first record when he was 18.
- 21. Elvis' song "It's Now or Never" is based on the Italian song "O Sole Mio"

- 22. "Wooden Heart" is actually an English version of a German folk song and was Elvis first No. 1 hit in the UK in 1961. It was from the movie "G.I. Blues".
- 23. Elvis caused outrage for some parts of the American society with his sultry looks, shaking hips and dynamic vocal style which drove many teenagers wild. On the 3rd and final appearance on the Ed Sullivan show he was filmed from the waist up to placate moralists.
- 24. Elvis' iconic "Aloha from Hawaii" aired on January 14 1973. It was the first entertainment special by a soloist artist to be broadcast live via satellite to over 40 countries across Asia and Europe. Over one billion people were said to have viewed the special.
- 25. Elvis only ever performed outside the USA once in Canada while on a 3-day tour there.
- 26. "It's Now or Never" was Elvis' biggest selling hit internationally.
- 27. Elvis' last released single was "Way Down". It was released two months before his death in 1977.
- 28. "Graceland" is a mansion in a 13.8-acre (5.6 hectare) estate in Memphis, Tennessee USA. His daughter Lisa Marie inherited the estate in 1993 when she turned 25. No one lives there now (although the family occasionally stay there) but it is open to the public daily.
- 29. Elvis named his private plane "Lisa Marie" after his daughter.
- 30. "Graceland" estate was named after the daughter of the previous owner. The house was constructed in 1939.
- 31. "Graceland" is the most visited privately owned house in America after the White House.
- 32. In 1956 on the Ed Sullivan show Elvis was shown receiving his polio vaccine in order to encourage teenagers to receive the vaccine. His influence worked, as between 1955 and 1957 polio cases dropped by 81% in the US.

Instructions for Music Bingo

- 1. Each pack contains Dementia friendly 20 Music Bingo cards, Song List and Fun Fact/Hints/Brain Teasers list.
- 2. Locate specific Music Bingo on Spotify (Kurrajonglodge).
- 3. <u>Connect to portable speaker</u>.
- 4. Hand out music Bingo sheet and Bingo tokens.
- 5. Each card contains 8 songs although 20 songs will be played.
- 6. Each game should take approximately ½ hour.
- 7. Play 10-20 seconds of the song (or until the chorus has been sung as this usually contains the key word/s or phrase). Often the song will be recognised long before 10 seconds has been played.
- 8. <u>Explain to the residents that they may not recognise the song but if</u> <u>they listen carefully, they should be able to pick up the title/keyword</u> <u>of the song.</u> (If they don't recognise the song one of the other residents will know the song or you can tell them after hints etc).
- 9. You can give HINTS, FUN FACTS AND BRAIN TEASER'S (see folder) to entertain, add stimulation or assist to recognise the song. Sometimes this will provoke a discussion/reminiscing about the song so just go with the flow. Occasionally you might end up singing a verse or chorus.
- 10. When Bingo is reached ask the residents to choose one of their favourite songs from the card that they would like to hear all the way through. Play the song then redistribute the sheets and begin a new game.
 IF YOU REPEAT A GAME PLAY THROUGH THE SONGS IN REVERSE.
- 11. At the end of the session wipe down all the cards with Clinell, spray bingo tokens with Glen 20 and return cards/fact sheets and song list to Bingo folder.
- 12. Return Music Bingo, tokens and portable speaker.
